Parent/Guardian Permission Form to apply Diaper Cream/Topical Ointment (Revised 2016)

As a parent/guardian, I recognize that my child is at risk of allergic reactions and irritations from soiled or wet diapers. Therefore, I give permission for the staff of Beachwood Nursery School & Early Learning Center to change my child's diaper and apply parent provided _____ (name of product)

- At the first sign of red, patchy irritation found in the genital area, the folds of the thighs and the buttocks.
- At every diaper change

Some of the most common causes of diaper rash I am aware of are:

- ✓ Irritation due to bowel movements
- ✓ Irritation due to moisture from sweat and urine
- ✓ Not drying the skin after a diaper change
- ✓ Diaper chafing and friction
- ✓ Diarrhea which may be caused by antibiotics
- ✓ Changes in food or the introduction of new food

I understand the diapering policy requires diapers to be checked and/or changed every 2 hours or sooner if necessary and involves the posted multi-step process that highlights:

1. **Wash** Hands; gather items; put on disposable gloves: (optional)
2. **Avoid** contact with soiled clothing and always **keep on hand on the child**;
3. Clean child from **front to back using a fresh wipe each time**;
4. Place soiled wipes in diaper, fold, use tabs to **reseal** , pull glove over diaper and discard;
5. Clean hands with a disposable wipe and **clean the child's hand** with a fresh disposable wipe;
6. Slide a clean diaper under child and **apply diaper cream with a tissue** & discard;
7. Complete diapering, dress child, **wash child's hands** with soap & water or wipes cleaning in between fingers for infants ;
8. Return child to **supervised** area;
9. Clean, Rinse, **Sanitize** the Diapering Area(Let solution sit for 2 minute to air dry or wipe dry;
- 10 Wash Hands; **Record diaper change**, diaper content and any problem on the daily log.
